Having spent most of her career in the financial services industry, Vickie joined the Denver Museum of Nature & Science, in 2004. As Director of Planned and Endowment Gifts, she is responsible for raising planned, endowment and major individual gifts. She is currently involved in the Museum's 12 year \$170 million campaign that will include the building of a Science Engagement Center and a Rocky Mountain Collections Center.

Originally from Chicago, Vickie began her career as a market analyst with Union Carbide in New York City, and spent more than twelve years as Director of Marketing and as Director of Brokerage Services at First Trust Corporation (Denver). Before coming to the Museum, she was Vice President of Retirement Services for Members Trust Company (Denver).

Vickie is a past co-chair of the Summer Symposium, currently serves on the board of the Colorado Planned Giving Roundtable, as well as on the Program and Symposium Scholarship Committees. She holds a Ph.D. in Public Administration from the University of Colorado (Denver), Graduate School of Public Affairs.
